In the past months, we organized performance concerts for them to gain more exposure and practice in public activities. Pray that they learn how precious and special they are in His eyes.

One of our Migrant Domestic Workers' shelters is faced with complaints and even hostility from the neighbours that puts extra strain on the clients who are in midst of their employment tribunals or sickness. Very high living costs in Hong Kong mean that many grassroots families have to work long hours to earn a living, leaving little time for family relationships. Today is a graduation ceremony for some special English classes run regularly over the past year. The initiative was sponsored by the International Christian Assembly for new arrival children and women.
