MODERN DAY SLAVERY - ABOLISHED BUT STILL FLOURISHING

Slavery today is often thought of as a relic of history, but extensive studies and media coverage globally have shown that it continues to flourish in our modern world. Over 60 percent of 45 million people living in modern slavery globally are in the Asia Pacific region. Contrary to the often held presumption that modern slavery only exists in poor countries, reports by the Global Slavery Index have shown that Hong Kong alone accommodates over 29'500 people who are potentially enslaved. Whereas in the past people were sold and shipped, today vulnerable women, children, and men are deceived and trapped into employments through debt-bondage or by confiscation of their identification documents. Local reports have suggested that 17% of the over 340,000 women and men serving as migrant domestic workers are also victims of forced labour or human trafficking.

CENTRE FOR MIGRANT DOMESTIC WORKERS

Established in 1993, Christian Action's Centre for Migrant Domestic Workers has provided comprehensive assistance to nearly 200,000 women and men who have been economically exploited, survived modern-day slavery and trafficking, or have been unfairly treated or abused, by offering them critical intervention and access to justice, shelter, food, psychological support, and empowerment through education opportunities that build their capacities to move beyond the domestic work sector when they return back home.

AWARENESS, OUTREACH, AND TEAM-BUILDING SESSIONS

Every Hong Kong person knows the contributions migrant domestic workers make to our families and city each year; yet few know of the hopes, challenges, and realities thousands of women face when leaving their families behind and coming to work in Hong Kong. Spreading awareness and providing platforms for the local community to engage with migrant domestic workers is one of our core priorities. Only with awareness can tendencies to react, to push away, to retaliate be replaced with allowance, acceptance, tolerance, and empathy.

With over 23 years of experience behind us, our workshops are tailor-made for different age groups and settings including schools, universities, corporate organisations, faith-based institutions and other community organisations. Through these highly interactive sessions, we educate our participants on the plight and cultures of migrant domestic workers in Hong Kong and around the globe.

2. Celebrate Diversity – Intercultural Competence Workshop

With the stronger interconnectedness of different nations, intercultural understanding becomes a crucial competence in the modern world. Specifically in international places like Hong Kong which function as a meeting point for people from different nations, it is important to be aware of differences and communalities of diverse cultures. Through this interactive workshop, students engage with different cultures and can learn to value and view critically their own cultural perspectives and practices and those of others. It offers opportunities for them to consider their own beliefs and attitudes in a new light, and gain more insight into how migrant domestic workers perceive Hong Kong and how they preserve their culture and cultural differences while living away from their homes.

- All activities will be automatically cancelled when the No. 8 typhoon, or red/ black rainstorm warnings are hoisted, or if the schools are closed for other reasons deemed necessary by the Education and Manpower Bureau of Hong Kong.
- Activities may be rescheduled to a later date if agreed upon by both the Centre for Migrant Domestic Workers and the school.
